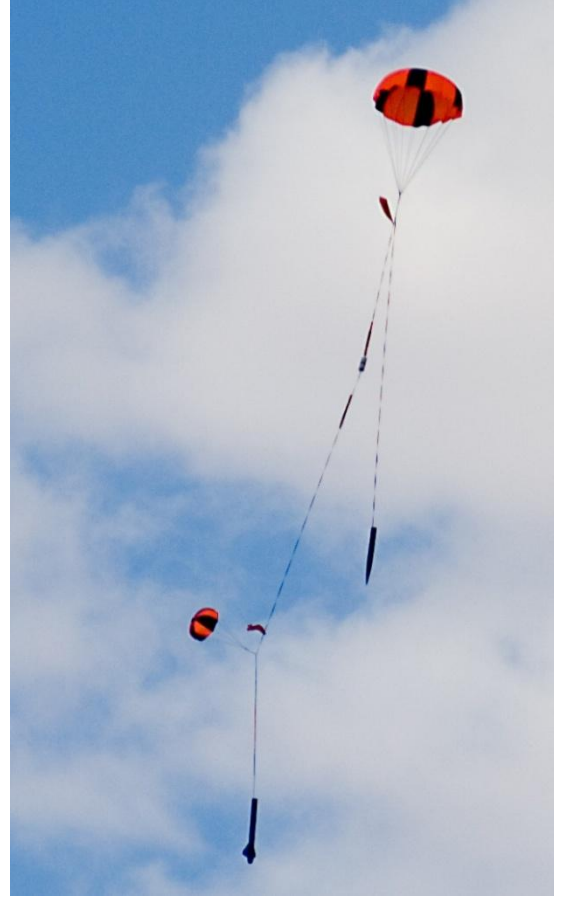

Mike Garrett's "Dark Matter" flew nicely to 5500' on a K500RL motor. The rocket is based on a Mad Dog DD kit.

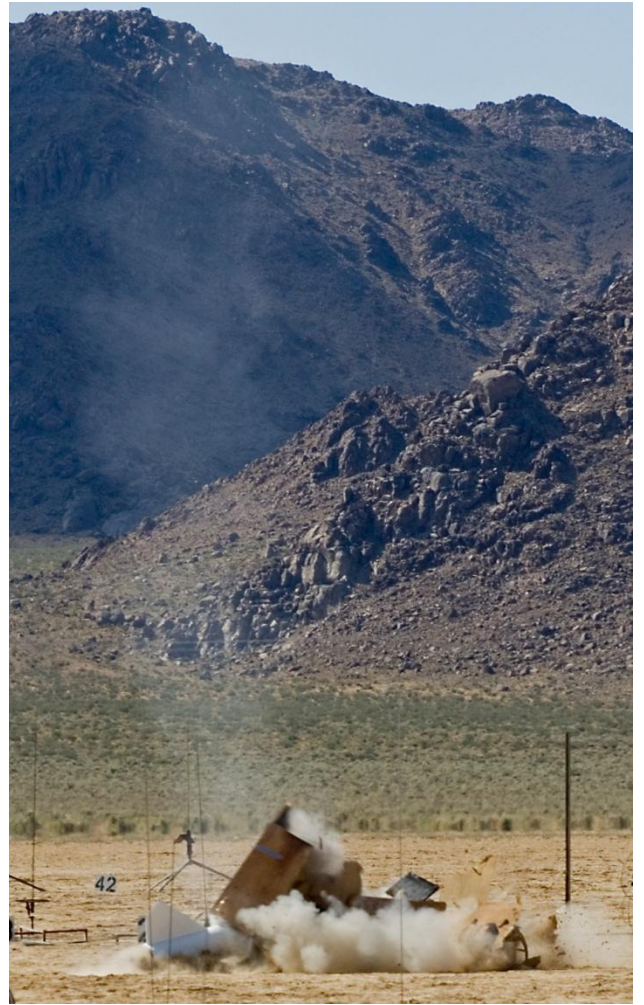


Mike Garrett's Super DX3
